CHAPTER I INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background to the Study

Everyone must have anxiety. Anxiety can be apprehensive to something. It happens caused by outside or inside of someone's self which causes inconvenience. This inconvenience can be like thought or feeling. Sometimes, people cannot deal with their inconvenience and make it worse.

Esther not only harms somebody, but she also kills to keep herself safe. Sister Abigail who takes care of her in orphanage, wants to tell the truth about who Esther in the past was to John and Kate. Because of that, Esther asks to Max to help her planning. Esther and Max wait on the side of the road which is not far away from house. Suddenly, Esther pushes Max to the road and makes Sister Abigail not focus to drive. When Sister Abigail comes out from the car, Esther hits the head of Sister Abigail from behind with hammer until die.

Following the events in *Orphan* movie, there are a lot of things that can analyse from psychological side, especially Esther, who has dangerous ego defence mechanism.

1.2 Statement of the Problem

Based on background to the study, the researcher will focus on analysis about the following problems :

- 1. Why does the main character "Esther" do ego defence mechanism?
- 2. What is the kind of ego defence mechanism in the main character?
- 3. What are the effects of ego defence mechanism to the other characters?

1.3 Objective of the Study
