

ABSTRAK

Penelitian yang saya lakukan membahas mengenai pengaruh Pendapatan Asli Daerah (PAD), Dana Alokasi Umum (DAU), Dana Alokasi Khusus (DAK), Dana Bagi Hasil (DBH) dan Pertumbuhan Ekonomi (PE) terhadap Belanja Modal (BM) pada Provinsi Jawa Tengah dan Jawa Timur periode 2017-2019.

Populasi dan sampel dalam penelitian yaitu sebanyak 35 Kabupaten/Kota di Provinsi Jawa Tengah dan 38 Kabupaten/Kota di Provinsi Jawa Timur. Sehingga, jumlah pengamatan Provinsi Jawa Tengah sebesar $35 \text{ Kabupaten/Kota} \times 3 = 105$ sampel pengamatan dan jumlah pengamatan Provinsi Jawa Timur sebesar $38 \text{ Kabupaten/Kota} \times 3 = 114$ sampel pengamatan.

Hasil penelitian yang dilakukan menghasilkan variabel Pendapatan Asli daerah (PAD), Dana Alokasi Umum (DAU) Dana alokasi khusus (DAK), Dana Bagi Hasil (DBH) berpengaruh positif signifikan. Sedangkan variabel Pertumbuhan Ekonomi tidak berpengaruh terhadap belanja modal baik di provinsi Jawa Tengah maupun Jawa Timur.

ABSTRACT

The research my conducted discusses the effect of regional original Local Revenue (PAD), General Allocation Funds (DAU), Special Allocation Funds (DAK), Revenue Sharing Funds (DBH) and Economic Growth (PE) on Capital Expenditures (BM) in Central and East Java provinces for the period of 2017-2019.

The population and samples in the study were 35 districts / cities in Central Java province and 38 districts / cities in East Java province. Thus, the number of observations in Central Java Province is 35 Regencies / Cities x 3 = 105 observation samples and the number of observations in East Java Province is 38 Regencies / Cities x 3 = 114 observation samples.

The results of the research carried out resulted in the variable regional local income (PAD), general allocation fund (DAU), special allocation funds (DAK), and profit sharing funds (DBH) had a significant positive effect. Meanwhile, the economic growth variable has no effect on capital spending in both the provinces of Central Java and East Java.
