INTRODUCTION

1.1. Background of The Study

According to Law No. 33 of 2009 concerning Movie in Article 1, the movie is a work of cultural art which is a social institution and mass communication media made based on cinematographic rules with or without sound and can be displayed. As a communication medium, the film can convey messages uniquely. The movie can visualize various characters through audio and visual elements contained in it so that it can easily intervene or influence the mind of the audience. As a material for research, I chose one of the best animated movies, Inside Out from Pixar Animation Studios, which was distributed by Walt Disney Motion Pictures in 2015. The movie is portrayed through imaginative characters based on five universal emotions (Joy, Sadness, Anger, Fear, and Disgust). In Piaget's view, early cognitive development involves processes that are based on actions and then develop into changes in mental operations. Piaget believes that children take an active role in the learning process, acting like little scientists when they conduct experiments, make observations, and learn about the world. When children interact with the world around them, they continue to add new knowledge, build on existing knowledge, and adapt ideas they previously had to accommodate new information. His theory not only focuses on understanding how children acquire knowledge but also on understanding the nature of intelligence. It also says that cognitive development helps increase our understanding of children's intellectual growth.

Previously, there has been a lot of research on the movie that has been done, but few talk about cognitive development based on intellectual knowledge, especially an animated movie. Besides, research on the knowledge of basic emotions is done more in analyzing this movie than analyzing intellectual cognitive development. This also becomes interesting for the writer to make it the object of research is seeing how the representation of the child's personality in the process of cognitive development in the movie and what influences it.

Based on the description above, I need to raise a study entitled: "Intellectual Cognitive Development of Riley's Character in Inside Out Films".
