CHAPTER 1

According to Wolf, the ideology of victim feminism might impede the development of women and cast them in the role of a victim. It is no longer possible to pretend that urges to dominate, attack, usurp, or exploit others is a 'brand' men's trade only because mental conditions have changed quite a bit and women's living conditions have changed quite a bit as well. Therefore, victim feminism can be considered obsolete due to these factors (Muslimin, 2019)

Power feminism the principle is (1) Women and men both have different roles big in life, (2) girl have the right to self-determination, (3) meaningful female experience, not just nonsense important, (4) women have the right to reveal the truth about the experience, and (5) decent woman receive respect from others, self-respect, education, safety, health, representation, and finance (Muslimin, 2019)

Because the theory was relevant to the issues that will be explored in the next chapter, the idea of power feminism that Naomi Wolf presented to the foundation in evaluating the movie *Moana* (2016) was used because it was the basis of the analysis.

This study uses the qualitative research approach for both the data collection and the analysis phases. The creation of qualitative research is a notion that helps us to comprehend social phenomena in natural settings by paying adequate emphasis to the experiences, meanings, and the participant's opinions. This kind of study is known as qualitative research. The study is carried out by categorizing the discourses and the situations mentioned in the screenplay that is relevant to the claims made about the issue.
