CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background

Vocabulary is a critical component of learning English. Children can benefit from reading a book to learn English, which can be a rewarding and life-changing experience. This is not the same as going to the movies. While watching is a fun and exciting activity, it can make a child feel as if he or she is not learning.
